Public Transportation

Malpensa Airport

The city center of Milan is accessible from Malpensa Airport via the Malpensa Express train. The ticket price is €15. The train arrives at Milano Cadorna station. From there, the green metro line (M2) in the direction of Assago/Abbiategrasso should be taken, with disembarkation at Porta Genova. Via Tortona 35 can then be reached with a 10-minute walk.

A single metro ticket costs €2.20 and contactless card payments are accepted. Alternatively, taxi service is available from Milano Cadorna station.

Linate Airport

Linate Airport is connected to the city center by the blue metro line (M4). Boarding is available at Linate Aeroporto station, with disembarkation at California. Via Tortona 35 can then be reached with a 10-minute walk.

Currency and Exchange

The currency in Italy is Euro (EUR).

All major credit cards are accepted in most hotels, shops, taxis and restaurants.

The Hotel does not have an ATM. The nearest ATM is in Via Bergognone 27, 8 minutes' walk from the hotel.

Climate

The temperature in Italy in October is generally mild and pleasant. The average daily is 16 C, with a maximum of 24 C and a minimum of 9 C. It is a good idea to bring along a jumper or light jacket for the evenings. Rains are possible.
